Langwarrin Park Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

Government funding alone does not provide the level of education and facilities currently enjoyed by students at LPPS – locally raised funds provided by parent contributions and community fundraising are essential in order to provide our students – your children – with diverse, high quality learning opportunities.

Financial Support for Families

Langwarrin Park Primary School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF): If you are a holder of a concession card, please be sure to complete an application form for 2021. Forms are available from the Finance Office and website link <https://www.education.vic.gov.au/Documents/about/programs/health/CSEF-Application-Form-2020.pdf>
- State School Relief (SSR): An application for support can be made through the school to assist with the purchase of uniforms for any families experiencing financial difficulties.
- Local Community Supports: Savers Plus Brotherhood of St Laurence

Payment Arrangements and Methods

Parents and guardians will be provided with early notice of payment requests for essential education items, optional extra and voluntary financial contributions (e.g. a minimum of six weeks' notice prior to the end of the previous school year).

Costs will be kept to a minimum with payment requests/letters fair and reasonable. To further assist parents with payments, four payment options have been developed.

- Option A Full –amount at the beginning of Term 1
- Option B Payment at the beginning of each Term
- Option C Half yearly payment – Term 1 and Term 3
- Option D Other payments arrangements as negotiated (i.e. weekly payments via Qkr)

Payments can be made via Qkr (our preferred payment method) or calling the Finance office and making a confidential credit card payment over the phone. Phone 9775 7533 and dial 2 for the Finance Office.



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Please go to the App Store or google play and download the Qkr app onto your device.

Alternative payment options are available through the school and parents are encouraged to make an appointment with the school to discuss circumstances and available options. If you have any queries please call the Finance Office and speak to Sue Guest, Bridgit Dooley or Shona Byrnes.

Refund

Refunds will be discussed on a case by case basis at a school level. A refund to families will be where it is reasonable and fair (for example, if the school has not incurred a cost) and for unavoidable event cancellations i.e. if a family experiences a crisis or sudden serious illness and the student can no longer attend the event.
